

Application for the 2017 Trot to Adopt - Nov. 11, 2017

Thank you for your interest in the 2017 Trot to Adopt, to be held on 11/11/2017. The Trot to Adopt is a fundraiser for families in the CSRA seeking financial assistance for their adoption process. It came about in 2011 for the purpose of raising funds for one family's adoption. Because of the impact it made on the community, rallying together for a child in need of a family, and because of the success in raising funds, prospective adopting families asked if there could be another Trot. The 2017 5K will be the seventh annual Trot to Adopt held at the Blanchard Woods Park in Evans. It is our desire to support families who intend to raise the child they are adopting in a Christ-centered home where they can live out the gospel daily.

"He took a little child and had him stand among them. Taking him In His Arms, He said to them, "whoever welcomes one of these little children in My name welcomes Me; and whoever welcomes Me does not welcome Me but the One who sent Me." Mark 9:36-37

We intend for all families selected to experience the greatest level of success from the Trot to Adopt. Therefore, it must be understood that the Trot to Adopt is an endeavor that requires work and a high level of commitment - much like a group fundraiser. Each family selected will be asked to be active participants, with the majority of the fundraising burden being divided among just a handful of families. We have found that those who raise the most funds are those families who have strong church, work and community ties. The race-fees are just a small part of the funds raised and shared among families. Most of the funds raised are from your 1) corporate sponsors and 2) contacts/supporters of the participants who sponsor the runners/walkers a dollar amount of their choice, earmarking their sponsorship dollars for one of the families.

Requirements for applicants (incomplete applications will not be accepted)

- applicants must live in the Central Savannah River Area (CSRA)
- financial need will be considered among applicants (within application)
- enclose a copy of your completed home study
- □ enclose your completed application with attached essay questions (1-5)
- provide 3 referrals postmarked by May 20 to address below
- □ application and documents must be postmarked by May 20, 2017:

- pastor's referral (letter should be from an elder if you are a full time pastor)

- Money will not be paid directly to the adoptive family, rather directly to the adoption agency.

- No party shall be deemed a third party beneficiary of any money raised.
- In order for the Trot to Adopt to do what it does best (raise funds for families through the 5K), it is necessary for us to partner with an organization that can manage and distribute the funds, as well as provide a federally recognized charity for donors to receive a tax deduction for all charitable contributions. - -To continue to make funds available to future Trot families, we encourage and expect families who receive Trot to Adopt-incurred funds to plan to "pay it forward" with an annual donation of at least \$200/year starting this year.
